Welcome dinner: **Sumida River Cruise dinner**. Viewing Tokyo's night light from the river, we will enjoy Tempura course dinner on the boat.

Day 2 (May 20) - Tokyo

We continue viewing majestic Mt.Fuji from one of the Fuji 5 lakes and Asama Shrine which has been worshipping Mt.Fuji since 859AD. We will also have a picturesque stop at Shirataki Waterfall.
